

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of Higher Education Services Program FY 2009 Budget Amendment #1-
Account # 10-1215)

RESOLUTION NO. 09-249


- 1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation through the Higher Education Services Program has been**
2 **successfully providing counseling and financial assistance to eligible Tohono**
3 **O'odham to attend Post Secondary Institutes; and**
- 4 **WHEREAS, the Higher Education Services Program FY 2009 Base Budget is at \$620,108.10 plus**
5 **Indirect Cost of \$10,542.40, a total of \$630,650.50, and the Grants and Contracts Office**
6 **has received the Bureau of Indian Affairs FY 2009 Final Allocation, Modification #78**
7 **in the amount of \$534,050.22, a decrease of \$86,057.88; and**
- 8 **WHEREAS, the Higher Education Services Program, through the Grants and Contract Office, has**
9 **identified Carry-forward funds from the FY 2007 and FY 2008 budgets in the amount**
10 **of \$253,330.10; and**
- 11 **WHEREAS, the Higher Education Services Program FY 2009 Budget of \$630,650.50 will be**
12 **increased \$168,272.22 bringing the total budget to \$798,135.57; and**
- 13 **WHEREAS, the FY 2009 Higher Education Services Program Amendment #1 will increases line**
14 **item 626 (Allowances and Stipends), 711 (Communications), 751 (Lease/Rental) and**
15 **decreases line item 810 (Professional Services); and**
- 16 **WHEREAS, the FY 2009 Higher Education Services Program Amendment #1 reflects an increase**
17 **of the indirect cost.**
- 18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
19 **Higher Education Services Program Budget Amendment #1 reflecting the FY 2009 Final**
20 **Allocation of \$534,050.22 and FY 2007 and FY 2008 Carry-Forward funds in the amount**
21 **of \$253,330.10.**
- 22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Higher Education Services Program FY 2009 Budget of**
23 **\$630,650.50 will be increased \$168,272.22 bringing the total Higher Education Services**
24 **Budget to \$798,135.57.**
- 25 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Chairman or Vice-Chairman is hereby**
26 **authorized to negotiate and execute the budget provided that any amendment**
27 **affecting the funding or funding levels of the budget shall be submitted for approval**
28 **by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**
