

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Amending the Plan of Operation for the Water Resources Committee)**

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 09-253**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to establish rules**  
2 **and procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council,**  
3 **standing committees, boards and special committees pursuant to the Constitution of**  
4 **the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(a) and (b); and**

5 **WHEREAS, in 2001 the Legislative Council did adopt a "Plan of Operation for Water Resources**  
6 **Committee" by Legislative Order No. 01-552; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Committee has drafted amendments to update the committees'**  
8 **Plan of Operations; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Rules Committee has reviewed the Water Resources Committee Plan of Operations**  
10 **amendments.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**  
12 **adopts the attached amended Plan of Operation for the Water Resources Committee**  
13 **as dated for reference May 2009, which shall supersede and replace the Plan of**  
14 **Operation adopted by Legislative Order No. 01-552.**

15 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11<sup>TH</sup> Day of**  
16 **MAY, 2009 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,907.4 FOR; 627.1 AGAINST;**  
17 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a)&(b)**  
18 **of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**  
19 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**  
20 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
