**RESOLUTION NO. 09-255**

- 1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council support**  
2 **the Districts in their efforts to improve quality of life for their communities and**  
3 **members; and**
- 4 **WHEREAS, efforts to improve quality of life in any one District are beneficial for the Nation as a**  
5 **whole; and**
- 6 **WHEREAS, the Department of Justice offers funding for Juvenile Delinquency prevention**  
7 **programs; and**
- 8 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District wishes to support it's youth by developing and implementing**  
9 **culturally sensitive delinquency prevention programs to provide prevention services**  
10 **to impact risk factors for delinquency, including risk factor identification, anti-gang**  
11 **education, youth gun violence reduction programs, truancy prevention programs**  
12 **and school drop out; and**
- 13 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is not planning to apply for this funding; and**
- 14 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Human Resources Development Committee and the Tohono**  
15 **O'odham Budget and Finance Committee are in support of this application; and**
- 16 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District is eligible for Department of Justice funding, provided a**  
17 **concurring resolution is obtained from the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council; and**
- 18 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier Education Department has the capacity to implement projects under**  
19 **the grant, and the District's Grants Manager and Finance Department have the**  
20 **capacity to administer this award; and**
- 21 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District agrees to accept all responsibilities for the implementation**  
22 **of this grant; and**
- 23 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Council, at its regular meeting on April 21, 2009 approved**  
24 **submission of this grant and requested a concurring resolution from the Tohono**  
25 **O'odham Legislative Council.**
- 26 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**  
27 **authorizes the San Xavier District to submit its application for the FY 2009, US**  
28 **Department of Justice, Office of Juvenile Justice Delinquency Prevention, Tribal**  
29 **Youth Program.**
- 30 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the San Xavier District assumes all liability resulting from the**  
31 **implementation of the FY 2009 Application to the US Department of Justice, Office of**  
32 **Juvenile Justice Delinquency Prevention, Tribal Youth Program award.**
