

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Fiscal Year 2010 Budget for the Tohono O'odham Nation Justice
Center and Appropriating Funds in the Amount of \$5,732,940.10)

RESOLUTION NO. 09-270

1 **WHEREAS, the fiscal year 2009 will end at midnight, September 30, 2009 and all spending**
2 **authority granted under the 2009 budgets terminate at that time; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Judicial Branch of the Nation has prepared and presented a budget to the**
4 **Legislative Council that reflects the needs of the Branch, a copy of the proposed said**
5 **budget is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the proposed FY 2010 Judiciary Budget includes employees salary in the amount of**
7 **\$3,594,251.70, other compensation at \$160,743.38, fringe benefits at 34% in the**
8 **amount of \$1,276,698.33, and operational cost in the amount of \$701,246.69, totaling**
9 **\$5,732,940.10 for FY 2010; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Judiciary Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee of the Legislative**
11 **Council of Tohono O'odham Nation have reviewed this budget.**


12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation**
13 **approves the Fiscal Year 2010 budget submitted by the Judicial Branch.**

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds in the amount of \$5,732,940.10 is appropriated and**
15 **authorized to be expended from the general funds approved by this Council for**
16 **support of the Fiscal Year 2010 budget of the Tohono O'odham Judicial Branch.**

17 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
18 **Chief Judge and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
19 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall**
20 **be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

21 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20TH. Day**
22 **of MAY, 2009 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,534.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
23 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [04]ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI**
24 **Section 1 (d)(2)&(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
25 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
26 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
27 **Stat. 984).**
