

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the FY 2010 Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services,
Division of Community Health - Department of Justice, Violence Against Women Grants
to Indian Tribal Governments, Account 11-1314)

RESOLUTION NO. 09-276

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Health and Human Services has been**
2 **administering a STOP Violence Against Indian Women Discretionary Grant, Account**
3 **number 11-1421 which no longer exists; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the funding source for domestic violence services has changed to Department of**
5 **Justice, Violence Against Women Grants to Indian Tribal Governments for FY 08 with**
6 **a new account number of 11-1314; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, the Tohono O'odham Police**
8 **Department, the Tohono O'odham Judicial Branch, the Tohono O'odham Victim**
9 **Witness Program of the Prosecutor's Office, and the Brewster Center for Domestic**
10 **Violence Services, Inc., have been collaborating to plan coordinated domestic violence**
11 **services; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Nation has received Department of Justice, Violence Against Women Grants to**
13 **Indian Tribal Governments to provide crisis intervention services to victims of**
14 **domestic violence for a three year period from October 1, 2008 - September 30, 2010**
15 **for a total amount of \$544,521.00.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE BE , IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby:**

- 17 **1. Approves the Prevention of Violence Against Women 12-month budget totaling**
18 **\$181,507.00 that is attached.**
- 19 **2. Authorizes the Nation to incur expenditures upon approval of this resolution**
20 **from October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010.**

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED: by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
22 **Nation officials, to wit: the Chairman and Vice Chairman and any designated official**
23 **are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any**
24 **amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for**
25 **further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20TH. Day**
27 **of MAY, 2009 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,534.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
28 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [03]ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI**
29 **Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
30 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
31 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
