

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services Recovery
Community Services Program FY2010)

RESOLUTION NO. 09-283

1 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, Recovery Community Services**
2 **Program provides support and prevention services; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Recovery Community Services Program submitted an application to the U.S.**
4 **Department of Health and Human Services/Center for Substance Abuse Treatment for**
5 **a Recovery Community Services Program grant to provide peer-to-peer prevention**
6 **programs to support individuals in recovery and their families on March 31, 2006; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Notice of Award was received for Fiscal Year 2007 on September 30, 2006 in the**
8 **amount of \$350,000 for the first year of a four-year grant; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Notice of Award was received for FY 2008 on June 23, 2007 in the amount of**
10 **\$350,000 for the second year of a four-year grant; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the grant is scheduled to be awarded for the third year for FY 2009; and**

12 **WHEREAS, of the total grant amount of \$350,000 the budget proposed for Year Three reflects**
13 **19.35% in indirect costs; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Recovery Community Services Program budget of \$350,000 for Year Four of the**
15 **grant is hereby submitted for review and approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
16 **Council.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
18 **and authorizes expenditures in accordance with the FY 2010 Recovery Community**
19 **Services Program grant, and attached budget in the amount of \$350,000 for the forth**
20 **year of a four year grant.**

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
22 **Chairman, and any designated official to expend and administer the budget, as**
23 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be**
24 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 21ST Day**
26 **of MAY, 2009 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,534.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
27 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [07]ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI**
28 **Section 1 (d)(2)(3) & (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
29 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
30 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
31 **Stat. 984).**


