

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving Memorandum of Understanding for TLO Level C (Connectivity) with Arizona**  
**Department of Public Safety Arizona Counter Terrorism Information Center)**

RESOLUTION NO. 09-339

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department (TONPD) has negotiated a**  
2 **Memorandum of Understanding for TLO Level C (Connectivity) ("Memorandum of**  
3 **Understanding") with the Arizona Department of Public Safety Arizona Counter**  
4 **Terrorism Information Center (ACTIC) to enhance the ACTIC Terrorism Liaison Officer**  
5 **(TLO) program intelligence collection and domestic preparedness for Chemical,**  
6 **Biological, Radiological, Nuclear, and Explosive (CBRNE) response service concerning**  
7 **the activities of terrorism; and**

8 **WHEREAS, under the Memorandum of Understanding the TONPD will assign a sworn police**  
9 **officer or law enforcement analyst who has been authorized by the TONPD to**  
10 **participate in the ACTIC Terrorism Liaison Officer (TLO) program; and**


11 **WHEREAS, the TONPD will be responsible for providing all equipment, personnel salary, and**  
12 **benefits related to the participation of the TONPD in the TLO program; and**

13 **WHEREAS, this Memorandum of Understanding has been reviewed by the Domestic Affairs**  
14 **Committee, which recommends approval by the Legislative Council.**


15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
16 **Memorandum of Understanding for TLO Level C (Connectivity) between the Tohono**  
17 **O'odham Nation and the Arizona Department of Public Safety Arizona Counter**  
18 **Terrorism Information Center substantially in the form attached hereto, and**  
19 **authorizes the Chairman of the Nation to execute the Memorandum of Understanding.**

20 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
21 **of JUNE, 2009 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,595.50 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
22 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI**  
23 **Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**  
24 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**  
25 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**






