

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving a Mutual Protection and Law Enforcement Agreement with Pinal County)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 09-340**

1 **WHEREAS, in 1995 the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") entered into a law enforcement mutual**  
2 **aid agreement with Pinal County to address the law enforcement needs of Florence**  
3 **Village in Pinal County for a three year term, and in 2002 the Nation entered into a**  
4 **similar agreement with Pinal County for a five year term; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the last agreement expired in 2007 and since that time the Nation and the County have**  
6 **been discussing the need for a new agreement; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Police Department continues to need a mutual aid arrangement**  
8 **with the Pinal County Sheriff's Department in order to adequately respond to calls**  
9 **from the Florence Village, Chui-chu, East Chui-chu, Whitehorse Pass, Jackrabbit,**  
10 **Kohatk, and the Cockleburr communities within Pinal County; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Nation and Gu Achi District wish to renew the Mutual Protection and Law**  
12 **Enforcement Agreement ("Agreement") with the Pinal County for another five year**  
13 **term, and Sif Oidak District has requested that the Agreement also provide law**  
14 **enforcement services for Chui-chu, East Chui-Chu, Whitehorse Pass, Jackrabbit,**  
15 **Kohatk and the Cockleburr communities within Pinal County; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Nation and Pinal County have negotiated a new form of the Agreement which**  
17 **provides law enforcement coverage by the Pinal County Sheriff's Department for the**  
18 **Florence Village, Chui-chu, East Chui-Chu, Whitehorse Pass, Jackrabbit, Kohatk, and**  
19 **the Cockleburr communities with in Pinal County; and**


20 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee has reviewed the proposed Agreement and**  
21 **recommends approval by the Legislative Council.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:**

- 23 **1. Approves the Mutual Protection and Law Enforcement Agreement with Pinal**  
24 **County Substantially in the form attached hereto.**
- 25 **2. Authorizes the Chairperson of the Nation to sign the Agreement on behalf of the**  
26 **Nation.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
28 **of JUNE, 2009 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,595.50 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
29 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI**  
30 **Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**  
31 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**  
32 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
