

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Authorizing the San Xavier District to Submit a FY 2009 Application to the US**  
**Department of the Interior, National Park Service, Native American Graves**  
**Protection and Repatriation Act, up to \$15,000)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 09-350**

- 1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports**  
2 **the Districts in their efforts to improve quality of life for their communities and**  
3 **members; and**
- 4 **WHEREAS, efforts to improve quality of life in any one District are beneficial for the Nation as a**  
5 **whole; and**
- 6 **WHEREAS, the US Department of the Interior, National Park Service, offers funding for the Native**  
7 **American Graves Protection and Repatriation Act; and**
- 8 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District wishes to apply through the Tohono O'odham Nation for a one**  
9 **year grant of up to \$15,000 to defray cost associated with the annual Reburial**  
10 **Ceremony held within the District; and**
- 11 **WHEREAS, the repatriation of the ancestors of Wa:k was conducted prior to the Native American**  
12 **Graves Protection and Repatriation Act becoming law on November 16, 1990; and**
- 13 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District was the first District within the Tohono O'odham Nation to**  
14 **conduct a reburial in 1984 due to discovered human remains along the banks of the**  
15 **Santa Cruz River due to the 1983 floods; and**
- 16 **WHEREAS, the Executive Office and the Cultural Affairs Office of the Tohono O'odham Nation are**  
17 **not planning to apply for this funding; and**
- 18 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District is eligible for the US Department of the Interior funding,**  
19 **provided a concurring resolution is obtained from the Tohono O'odham Legislative**  
20 **Council; and**
- 21 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Cultural Resource Office has the capacity to implement**  
22 **projects under this grant, and the District's Grants Manager and the Financial**  
23 **Department have the capacity to administer this award; and**
- 24 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District agrees to accept all responsibilities for the implementation of**  
25 **this grant; and**
- 26 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District will not be required to provide a cash "match" for this grant;**  
27 **and**
- 28 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Council, at its regular meeting on April 21, 2009 approved**  
29 **submission of this grant and requested a concurring resolution for the Tohono**  
30 **O'odham Legislative Council; and**
- 31 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Cultural Preservation Committee and the Budget and Finance**  
32 **Committee at its regular meetings on May 12, 2009 are in support of this application.**



1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby  
2 authorizes the San Xavier District to submit its application for the FY 2009, US  
3 Department of the Interior, National Park Service, Native American Graves Protection  
4 and Repatriation Act Grant of up to \$15,000.


5 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the San Xavier District assumes all liability resulting from the  
6 implementation of the FY 2009 Application to the US Department of the Interior,  
7 National Park Service, Native American Graves Protection and Repatriation Act Grant.

8 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11<sup>TH</sup>. Day  
9 of JUNE, 2009 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,595.50 FOR; -0- AGAINST;  
10 -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI  
11 Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham  
12 Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs  
13 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




