

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Authorizing Tohono O'odham Nation Delegation to the National Congress of American**  
**Indians' 2009 Mid-Year Conference)**

RESOLUTION NO. **09-360**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to consult with the**  
2 **federal government and other Indian tribes on all matters within the Council's**  
3 **authority (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and**

4 **WHEREAS, the National Congress of American Indians ("NCAI") will hold its 2009 Mid-Year**  
5 **Conference in Niagara Falls, New York from June 14 - 17, 2009; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has worked closely with NCAI and with Indian tribes**  
7 **across the United States to address numerous national issues of importance to Indian**  
8 **people; and**

9 **WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Tohono O'odham Nation to continue its national-level**  
10 **involvement in these issues by participating in the NCAI 2009 Mid-Year Conference.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**  
12 **authorizes the following officials to attend and serve as the Tohono O'odham Nation's**  
13 **delegation to the NCAI 2009 Mid-Year Conference:**

- 14       ▪ **Tohono O'odham Nation Chairman Ned Norris, Jr., Voting Delegate;**
- 15       ▪ **Legislative Council Vice Chairperson Felicia Nuñez; Alternate Voting Delegate;**
- 16       ▪ **Representative Timothy Joaquin, Alternate Voting Delegate;**
- 17       ▪ **Representative Evelyn Juan Manuel;**
- 18       ▪ **Representative Lorraine Eiler;**
- 19       ▪ **Representative Cynthia Manuel;**
- 20       ▪ **Representative Mary Lopez; and**
- 21       ▪ **Representative Chester Antone.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby delegates authority**  
23 **to Chairman Ned Norris, Jr. to act as the Tohono O'odham Nation's voting delegate,**  
24 **and Legislative Council Vice-Chairperson Felicia Nunez and Representative Timothy**  
25 **Joaquin to act as the Nation's alternate voting delegates to the NCAI 2009 Mid-Year**  
26 **Conference.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11<sup>TH</sup>. Day**  
28 **of JUNE, 2009 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,595.50 FOR; ~~0~~ AGAINST;**  
29 **~~0~~ NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI**  
30 **Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**  
31 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**  
32 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
