

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving for Wildland Fire Management Amendment No. 1)

RESOLUTION NO. 09-362

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation/Department of Public Safety/Fire Department has taken**
2 **over Operations of the P.L. 93-638, Wildland Fire Management (Preparedness) from**
3 **the Bureau of Indian Affairs to operate the program indefinitely; and**

4 **WHEREAS, funding has been provided by BIA Wildland P.L. 93-638, for the operation of the**
5 **Wildland Fire Management (Preparedness); and will be utilized to provide emergency**
6 **services in saving of lives, property, and protect the natural resources and wildlife of**
7 **the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Wildland Fire Management Division/Fire Department request approval to include**
9 **the FY 2008 carry forward funds of \$159,757.93 to the original FY 2009 Budget; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Wildland Fire Management Division/Fire Department request approval to include**
11 **the additional \$24,560.00 for purchase of the following critical needs: 1 Stationary**
12 **Radio Repeater and 20 fire shelters for the Tohono O'odham Fire Management**
13 **Program, awarded by Bureau of Indian Affairs to the original FY 2009 Budget; and**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
15 **FY 2008 carry forward identified savings of \$159,757.93, the increase of \$24,560.00**
16 **awarded by the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and the FY 2009 IDC in the amount of**
17 **\$30,408.33 for a grand total amendment of \$214,726.26. Also adding two new line items**
18 **612 Occasional Appointments and 750 Major Capitol to purchase 1 Stationary Radio**
19 **Repeater and 20 fire shelters.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
21 **Nation's official, to wit; the Chairperson is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute**
22 **the contracts and plans, provided however, that any amendment affecting the funding**
23 **or funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this**
24 **Council.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 22ND. Day**
26 **of JUNE, 2009 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,390.8 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
27 **-0- NOT VOTING; and 204.7 [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI**
28 **Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
29 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
30 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
