

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving the Pia-Oik Community Budget Amendment No. 2 Fiscal Year 2009)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 09-378**

1 **WHEREAS, the Gu-Vo District did bring forth the Pia-Oik Community's Budget Amendment No.**  
2 **2 for the Fiscal Year 2009 Budget; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Pia-Oik Community is requesting adjustment to the justification in their FY'2009**  
4 **Budget to assist the Community Members; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the proposed amendment from the Pia-Oik Community has gone through proper**  
6 **reviews from the Gu-Vo District and the Tohono O'odham Legislative Budget and**  
7 **Finance Committee; and**

8 **WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Budget & Finance Committee to approve Amendment**  
9 **#2 for Pia-Oik Community amending justification.**

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**  
11 **the Budget Amendment #2 for Pia-Oik Community and is amending the justification**  
12 **of line item 860 Special Activities-the original justification states;**

13 ***"Youth gathering for 3 major holidays: 1) Halloween @\$500.00 2) Christmas @\$500.00***  
14 ***3) Easter @\$500.00. Totaling: \$1,500.00. Christmas gifts for youth @ \$25.00 per child***  
15 ***x 35 children (estimated) Total: \$875.00. Community Youth Projects, Recreational***  
16 ***Field Trips (In or Out of State), Bingo and other youth activities. Budgeted @***  
17 ***\$10,000.00. Community Elder Trips and outing Budgeted @ \$3,000.00."***

18 **And the amended justification addition is as follows;**

19 ***"To provide funding for the Pia-Oik Community Youth for their in and out of state***  
20 ***trips; including but not limited to; lodging, spending money, admissions, parking fees,***  
21 ***meal allowance and other fee that relates to in & out of state trips."***

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**  
23 **Chairman and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**  
24 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be**  
25 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06<sup>TH</sup>. Day**  
27 **of JULY, 2009 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,390.8 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
28 **-0- NOT VOTING; and 204.7[03]ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1**  
29 **(d)(2) and (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
30 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
31 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
32 **18, 1924 (48 Stat. 984)**
