

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Acceptance and Approval of the US Department of Homeland Security, FEMA, 2008**  
**Homeland Security Grant Program #2008-GE-T8-0063 for \$175,500.00)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 09-392**

1 **WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management**  
2 **Agency (FEMA) has distributed grants states to fund for purchases that provide public**  
3 **safety services within their respective jurisdictions; and**

4 **WHEREAS, eligible Indian tribes have been designated to receive direct funding from the**  
5 **Department of Homeland Security - FEMA established from the 9-11**  
6 **Recommendations Act; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has submitted an application for FY2008 to FEMA for**  
8 **direct funding; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has been awarded a grant from the Department of**  
10 **Homeland Security, FEMA in the amount of \$175,500.00 as part of the 2008 Homeland**  
11 **Security Grant Program to help strengthen the Nation against risks associated with**  
12 **potential terrorist attacks and natural disasters; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the grant guidance for this grant award only allows three percent for indirect costs to**  
14 **be charged to manage and administer the grant; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the 2008 Homeland Security Grant Program Grant Program No. 2008-GE-T8-0063**  
16 **award in the amount of \$175,500.00 has been reviewed by the Office Grants &**  
17 **Contracts, Executive Office, Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget & Finance**  
18 **Committee, of which all recommend acceptance of the grant award by the Legislative**  
19 **Council.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts and**  
21 **approves the 2008 Homeland Security Grant Program No. 2008-GE-T8-0063 in the**  
22 **amount of \$175,500.00 on a reimbursement basis from the Tohono O'odham Nation**  
23 **General Fund.**

24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative council approves and authorizes**  
25 **the Office of Emergency Management to expend funds from the FEMA 2008 Homeland**  
26 **Security Grant Program in accordance with the terms of the grant award period of**  
27 **09/01/08 to 08/31/2011 and further waives the three percent indirect costs to**  
28 **administer this grant.**

29 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
30 **Nation's Officials to wit: the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official are**

amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for further prior approval.

Day of JULY, 2009 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,595.50 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI Section 1 (d)(2)&(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
