

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the Public Health Preparedness and Response – Bio-terrorism (BT)
FY 2009 Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 09-442

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is concerned with the health, welfare and safety of its**
2 **members who reside on or near the Tohono O'odham Nation Reservation, including**
3 **the O'odham in Mexico; and**

4 **WHEREAS, Public Health Preparedness and Response for Bioterrorism is within the charter of the**
5 **Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Community**
6 **Health Service; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with**
8 **the Arizona Department of Health Services (ADHS) for (Public Health) Preparedness**
9 **and Response for Bioterrorism on August 31, 2003; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation in Resolution No. 04-265 approved the IGA; and**

11 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 05-230, the IGA budget amendment No. 1 was approved and included**
12 **the provision to extend the IGA to August 30, 2008, and expanded the Scope of Work to**
13 **provide for Surveillance and Epidemiology focus areas; and**

14 **WHEREAS, ADHS Fiscal Year 2009 BT funding notice was received and budget prepared in the**
15 **amount of \$80,096.00; and**

16 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 09-123, a new IGA for the period August 9, 2008 through August 8,**
17 **2013 was approved by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby:**

- 19 **1. Approves the BT budget in the amount of \$80,096.00.**
- 20 **2. Authorizes the Nation to obligate and expend funds, upon approval of this**
21 **resolution, through August 8, 2009.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
23 **Nation officials, to wit: the Chairman and Vice-Chairman and any designed official are**
24 **hereby authorized to negotiate annual contract period performance terms and its**
25 **associated budget, provided however, that any amendment affecting the funds or**
26 **funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono**
27 **O'odham Legislative Council.**

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04TH Day**
29 **of AUGUST, 2009 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,318.5 FOR; -0-**
30 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 277.0 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
31 **Section 1 (d)(2)(3) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by**
32 **the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
33 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
34 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
