

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving the FY 2010 Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA)**  
**Access to Health Care Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 09-465**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation did submit for the Health Resources and Services**  
2 **Administration (HRSA) Access to Health Care Earmark Funding for the purchase of**  
3 **telehealth/telemedicine equipment and programming to improve health care for**  
4 **diabetes management; and**

5 **WHEREAS, videoconference equipment will enable local diabetes health care and education, the**  
6 **videoconferencing telemedicine systems will be located in four districts on the Tohono**  
7 **O'odham Nation; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) did collaborate with the**  
9 **Department of Information and Technology (DoIT) in the FCC Pilot Program for**  
10 **Enhanced Access to Advanced Telecommunications and Information Services; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Access to Health Care telemedicine project is dependent upon the wireless**  
12 **infrastructure to be built by the FCC Pilot Project and the DHHS and the Division of**  
13 **Community Health Services are among several partners in this endeavor; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the HRSA Earmark Funding was awarded, on 8/21/08, in the grant amount of**  
15 **\$117,697.37 to enable the Nation to establish the videoconferencing telemedicine**  
16 **systems; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the HRSA did issue, on 8/11/09, a one-year no cost extension revising the original**  
18 **project and budget period to extend through August 31, 2010.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**  
20 **accept, approve and authorize expenditures in the HRSA Access to Health Care**  
21 **telemedicine grant award of \$117,697.37 for the project and budget period of**  
22 **September 1, 2008 through August 31, 2010, with the attached budget.**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation officials to wit: the Chairperson or any**  
24 **designated official is hereby authorized to execute the grant, provided however, that**  
25 **any amendments affecting the funding or funding level shall be submitted for**  
26 **approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
28 **of AUGUST, 2009 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,595.50 FOR; -0-**  
29 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
30 **Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
31 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
32 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
33 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
