

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval for Kenneth Madsen to Perform Research on Border Fences on the
Tohono O'odham Nation)

RESOLUTION NO. 09-499

1 **WHEREAS, on September 15, 2009 Kenneth Madsen presented a proposal to do research**
2 **(interviewees, informal discussion and observation, archival work, photography) on**
3 **border fences to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council and answered questions**
4 **about the project; and**

5 **WHEREAS, Kenneth has many years of experience and service working with Tohono O'odham on**
6 **his graduate school studies (dissertation completed at ASU in 2005), employment, and**
7 **social and cultural activities resulting in a basic understanding of the O'odham**
8 **language and a sensitivity to Tohono O'odham cultural concerns; and**

9 **WHEREAS, Kenneth has agreed to disclose how information will be used to prospective**
10 **interviewees (including possible publication), to obtain and track verbal or written**
11 **informed consent for the use of such information, provide an opportunity for review**
12 **and correction of information collected, and respect people's privacy by allowing**
13 **them to remain anonymous if they so desire; and**

14 **WHEREAS, Kenneth agrees to provide occasional updates on this project to the Cultural**
15 **Preservation Committee of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council; and**

16 **WHEREAS, this research is part of a larger project along the Arizona-Sonora stretch of border,**
17 **following-up on previously done work on border fences done for Kenneth's Master's**
18 **Thesis at ASU (completed in 1999) with a goal of which is a better understanding of the**
19 **impact border fences and related policies have had on local communities, how local**
20 **individuals have reacted to such construction, and how federal policy and**
21 **international economic and political forces are reflected in such structures; and**

22 **WHEREAS, Kenneth has obtained a resolution of support from the Chukut Kuk District Council**
23 **and will also work with other districts and communities before interviewing members**
24 **or taking photographs in those locations.**

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
26 **Kenneth Madsen to perform research on border fences and activities relating to this**
27 **project within the Tohono O'odham Nation.**

28 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of printed results be donated to interested libraries on**
29 **the Tohono O'odham Nation and copies of any transcripts or recordings (if permission**
30 **is given by interviewees, appropriately redacted if necessary and with a time embargo**
31 **for public access as per the wishes of the interviewee) be donated to such an**
32 **appropriate location on the Tohono O'odham Nation as well.**

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 15TH. Day of SEPTEMBER, 2009 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,595.50 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
