

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Holding November 20, 2009 Legislative Council Session at Pima County Administration
Building)**

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 09-607

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power "to establish rules and procedures to**
2 **regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing committees, boards**
3 **and special committees." (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI,**
4 **Section 1(a)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, Article I, Section 2.C. of the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
6 **Council, as amended, provides that "[a]ll Legislative Council sessions shall be held at**
7 **the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council chambers located in Sells, Tohono O'odham**
8 **Nation, with the following exceptions. . . . [a] majority of all the legislative**
9 **representatives may vote to hold a session in some location other than the chambers**
10 **located at Sells."; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation Committee has recommended that the November 20, 2009**
12 **general session be held in Tucson to allow attendance by the Legislative Council to the**
13 **unveiling of the Tohono O'odham Nation's poster ceremony scheduled to take place**
14 **at the Pima County Administration building in downtown Tucson with a reception**
15 **immediately following at Desert Diamond II.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that roll call for**
17 **the November 20, 2009 general session shall be conducted at the Pima County**
18 **Administration building in downtown Tucson at 9:45 a.m., followed by the unveiling**
19 **of the Tohono O'odham Nation's poster ceremony and reception.**

20 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 18TH. Day of**
21 **NOVEMBER, 2009 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,595.50 FOR;-0-**
22 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
23 **Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
24 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
25 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
26 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
