RESOLUTION NO. 09-629

1 **WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security has distributed grants to**
2 **counties, through their respective states, to fund for purchases that provide public**
3 **safety services within their respective jurisdictions; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation was previously awarded a grant from the Arizona**
5 **Department of Homeland Security, in the amount of \$58,710.00 as part of the 2007**
6 **State Homeland Security Program for purchase of necessary equipment to fulfill the**
7 **security and operations improvements required for the Police and Fire Departments;**

9 **WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Homeland Security, State Homeland Security Program**
10 **Grant No. 2007-GE-T7-0006 approval of the Subgrantee Agreement Amendment #1**
11 **which extends the grant period from 10/10/2007 thru 07/31/2009 to 10/10/2007 thru**
12 **09/30/2009 has been reviewed by the Grants & Contracts Office, and the Domestic**
13 **Affairs Committee, of which all recommend acceptance of the grant extension by the**
14 **Legislative Council.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
16 **Subgrantee Agreement Amendment #1 for the purchase of necessary equipment to**
17 **fulfill the security and operations improvements required for enhancing the Tohono**
18 **O'odham Nation, Police Department.**

19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorized the Police**
20 **Department and Fire Department to expend funds from this grant during the award**
21 **period of 10/10/07 to 09/30/09.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
23 **Nation's Office to wit; the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official are**
24 **authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any**
25 **amendments affecting the funding or funding levels or any extensions of the grant**
26 **shall be submitted for further prior approval.**
