

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Acceptance and Approval of the US Department of Homeland Security, FEMA,
2009 State Homeland Security Program - Tribal #2009-33-T9-0073 for \$194,000.00)

RESOLUTION NO. 09-641

1 **WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management**
2 **Agency (FEMA) has distributed grants states to fund for purchases that provide public**
3 **safety services within their respective jurisdictions; and**

4 **WHEREAS, eligible Indian tribes have been designated to receive direct funding from the**
5 **Department of Homeland Security - FEMA established from the 9-11**
6 **Recommendations Act; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has submitted an application for FY2009 to FEMA for**
8 **direct funding; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has been awarded a grant from the Department of**
10 **Homeland Security, FEMA in the amount of \$194,000.00 as part of the 2009 State**
11 **Homeland Security Program - Tribal to help strengthen the Nation against risks**
12 **associated with potential terrorist attacks and natural disasters; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the 2009 State Homeland Security Program - Tribal Grant No. 2009-33-T9-0073 award**
14 **in the amount of \$194,000.00 has been reviewed by the Office of Grants & Contracts,**
15 **Executive Office, Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget & Finance Committee, of**
16 **which all recommend acceptance of the grant award by the Legislative Council.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts and**
18 **approves the 2009 State Homeland Security Program - Tribal No. 2009-33-T9-0073 in**
19 **the amount of \$194,000.00 on a reimbursement basis from the Tohono O'odham**
20 **Nation General Fund.**

21 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative council approves and authorizes**
22 **the Office of Emergency Management to expend funds from the FEMA 2009 State**
23 **Homeland Security Program - Tribal in accordance with the terms of the grant award**
24 **period of 08/01/09 to 07/31/2012 and further waives the three percent indirect costs**
25 **to administer this grant.**

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
27 **Nation's Officials to wit: the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official are**
28 **authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any**
29 **amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted**
30 **for further prior approval.**
