

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving FY 2010 Planning Department Budget for Youth Transportation**  
**Art Program)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 09-643**

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Tohono O'odham Legislative**  
2 **Council with the authority to "consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and**  
3 **contracts on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local**  
4 **governments" and "to adopt, approve and amend annual budgets and to authorize the**  
5 **expenditure of funds in accordance with these budgets" (Constitution, Article VI,**  
6 **Section 1(d) and (f)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Planning Department applied for and received Youth Transportation Art Program**  
8 **grant funding from the Pima Association of Governments for \$50,000.00 in FY 2005 and**  
9 **\$175,000.00 in FY 2006, for a total grant amount of \$225,000.00 to enhance community**  
10 **pride by involving District youth in designing public transportation art; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the current grant funding period will end on December 31, 2009; and**

12 **WHEREAS, three projects have been awarded funding in the amounts of \$25,000.00 for San Xavier**  
13 **District; \$25,000.00 for Hickiwan District; and \$30,400.00 for Pisinemo; and**

14 **WHEREAS, because the Pisinemo District project has not begun and there is insufficient time to**  
15 **complete the project, it will be resubmitted in the next round of Youth Transportation**  
16 **Art Program grant funding in 2010; and**

17 **WHEREAS, Hickiwan District has expended \$948.80 from the FY 2006 budget, leaving a remaining**  
18 **balance for Hickiwan District and San Xavier District of \$49,051.20; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the Planning Department is requesting approval for the FY 2010 Planning Department**  
20 **Budget for Youth Transportation Art Grant to use the remaining funds awarded to San**  
21 **Xavier and Hickiwan District in the amount of \$49,051.20; and**

22 **WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Committee, Budget and Finance Committee, and Executive**  
23 **Branch reviewed and recommended approval of the FY 2010 Planning Department**  
24 **Budget for Youth Transportation Art Grant.**

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**  
26 **approves the FY 2010 Planning Department Budget for Youth Transportation Art**  
27 **Program for the use of \$49,051.20.**

28 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Planning Department is authorized to expend the funds in the**  
29 **amount of \$49,051.20 beginning October 1, 2009, in accordance with attached budget,**  
30 **provided that any amendments to the budget shall be submitted to the Legislative**  
31 **Council for approval.**


