Crime in the amount of \$348,827.09)**

RESOLUTION NO. 11-009

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department was awarded and accepted the**
2 **Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Recovery Act Rural Law**
3 **Enforcement Assistance: Combating Rural Crime in the amount of \$394,724.00 under**
4 **resolution no. 10-043; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the funding for this grant period is August 1, 2009 through July 31, 2011; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the TONPD has created a FY 2011 budget as attached for the remaining funds of**
7 **\$348,827.09 that includes indirect cost at \$34,883.69 and has been reviewed by the**
8 **Office of Grants & Contracts, Executive Office, Domestic Affairs Committee and**
9 **Budget & Finance Committee, of which all recommend acceptance of the FY 2011**
10 **budget by the Legislative Council; and**

11 **WHEREAS, Indirect Costs are restricted and cannot be obligated, expended or drawdown per**
12 **Grant Adjustment Notice (GAN) No. 004 dated June 18, 2010, Modified Special**
13 **Condition No. 37, until an approved indirect cost negotiated agreement is in place for**
14 **the period covering October 1, 2010 through July 31, 2011.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
16 **approves the attached FY 2011 budget in the amount of \$348,827.09 with indirect cost**
17 **of \$34,883.69.**

18 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby authorizes the**
19 **Chairman and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
20 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall**
21 **be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 03RD Day**
23 **of JANUARY, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,421.0 FOR; -0-**
24 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 174.50[05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
25 **by Article VI, Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
26 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
27 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
28 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


