

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving and Authorizing Amendment #1 of KOHN 91.9 FM's Corporation for
Public Broadcasting Community Service Grant FY 2011 Budget; increasing the
budget from \$197,821.06 to \$208,022.06)**

RESOLUTION NO. 11-051

1 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 10-304, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council (Council) approved**
2 **and authorized the KOHN 91.9 FM's Corporation for Public Broadcasting (CPB)**
3 **Community Service Grant (CSG) for fiscal year 2011; and**

4 **WHEREAS, KOHN has prepared the attached budget amendment one (1), incorporated into this**
5 **resolution by this reference, to obligate an increase in the Community Services Grant,**
6 **in the amount of \$8,739.00; and an unobligated 2010 balance of \$1,462.00 allocated for**
7 **the Rural Listener Access Incentive Fund bonus allocation (RLAIF) for a total**
8 **amendment to the budget of \$10,201.00, increasing the fiscal year 2011 KOHN CPB**
9 **budget from \$197,821.06 to \$208,022.06; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the amendment provides for estimated cost of KOHN's internet stream; an additional**
11 **amount for KOHN's stand alone audit; and for training costs for programming staff;**
12 **and**

13 **WHEREAS, KOHN management has presented the attached amendment one of its FY 2011 CPB**
14 **CSG grant to the Executive Office; the Culture Preservation and Budget & Finance**
15 **Committees, all of which recommended approval by the Legislative Council.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
17 **approves and authorizes Amendment one of KOHN 91.9 FM's CPB CSG FY 2011 budget**
18 **to be expended as attached; increasing the fiscal year 2011 KOHN CPB budget by**
19 **\$10,201.00 from \$197,821.06 to \$208,022.06.**

20 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it approves the funding of the new account; 830 - Audit.**

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
22 **Nation's Officials to-wit: the Chairman, and any designated official, are authorized to**
23 **execute the grant, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funds or**
24 **funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono**
25 **O'odham Legislative Council.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH Day**
27 **of FEBRUARY, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,595.50 FOR; -0-**
28 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article**
29 **VI, Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
30 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
31 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
32 **Stat. 984).**
