

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the U.S Department of Justice Community Oriented Policing Services Hiring
Recovery Program Grant for FY 2011 budget in the amount of \$183,683.42)

RESOLUTION NO. 11-064

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department (TONPD) received and accepted a**
2 **three year grant award from the U.S. Department of Justice Community Oriented**
3 **Policing Services Hiring Recovery Program (CHRP) grant in the amount of \$622,710.00**
4 **for grant period of July 1, 2009 thru June 30, 2012 per TOLC Resolution No. 09-587; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the grant funds three years of salary and fringe benefits for three sworn Police**
6 **Officers; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the TOLC Resolution NO. 09-587 approved the FY 2010 budget for year one for entry**
8 **level funding for the period of July 1, 2009 thru June 30, 2010 in the amount of**
9 **\$184,535.33; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the TOPD has hired all three (3) entry-level police officers as of January 4, 2010, and**
11 **from this point on begins the entry-level budget period of 12 months per the grant**
12 **guidance ; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the current FY 2011 budget will expire on December 31, 2010 requiring for another**
14 **budget from the period of January 1, 2011 thru December 31, 2011 as provided in the**
15 **budget attached which begins the second year of the grant; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the grant does not allow Indirect Cost; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the attached FY 2011 budget has been reviewed and approved for the period of January**
18 **1, 2011 through December 31, 2011 by the budget office, Grants & Contracts, Executive,**
19 **Domestic Affairs and the Budget & Finance and recommends approval.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
21 **approves the FY 2011 budget as attached for the period of January 1, 2011 through**
22 **December 31, 2011 from the FY 2009 Recovery, COPS Hiring Recovery Program (CHRP).**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby authorizes the**
24 **Chairman and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
25 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be**
26 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH Day**
28 **of FEBRUARY, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,421.0 FOR; -0-**
29 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 174.50[05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
30 **by Article VI, Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
31 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
32 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
33 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
