

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Planning & Economic Development Department to Submit an
Application for the 2011 Competition Period to the Administration for Native
Americans for a Mapping Project)**

RESOLUTION NO. 11-090

1 **WHEREAS, the Executive Office Chairman has instructed the Planning & Economic Development**
2 **Department to complete a Comprehensive Long Range Plan for the Nation; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Administration for Native Americans (ANA), Administration for Children &**
4 **Families, U.S. Department of Health & Human Services issued a Notice Of Funds**
5 **Available; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation applied for and received a grant from ANA in 2002 to**
7 **complete a Needs Assessment for a Land Use Plan; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Needs Assessment concluded one of the Next Steps should be mapping of existing**
9 **& proposed land uses; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Planning & Economic Development Department proposes to seek funding from**
11 **ANA for a three-year project to initiate the mapping components of the**
12 **Comprehensive Long Range Plan and the Next Steps from the 2002 ANA Grant; and**

13 **WHEREAS, ANA requires a Resolution from the Legislative Council specific to this grant**
14 **application.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
16 **the grant application to ANA by the Planning and Economic Development Department**
17 **for the mapping project titled, "Geo Education for O'odham: Spatial Mapping**
18 **Assessment & Resource Training (G.E.O. S.M.A.R.T.)".**

19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the 20% match is being provided with in-kind contributions.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that should the grant be awarded, the Planning and Economic**
21 **Development Department will further submit for approval and acceptance of the final**
22 **budget and that any amendments affecting the funding levels will be submitted for**
23 **further prior approval by this council.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH Day**
25 **of MARCH, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,396.80 FOR; -0-**
26 **AGAINST; 198.70 [03] NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
27 **by Article VI, Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
28 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
29 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
30 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
