

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving SWMP Carry over Funding for FY-2011 in the Amount of \$99,629.50 to  
Complete the Construction of the Solid Waste Transfer Station)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 11-092**

1 **WHEREAS, a detailed cost analysis of the Tohono O'odham Solid Waste Management Program**  
2 **(SWMP) by EMCON – Tucson in 2002 indicated that substantial operational savings will**  
3 **occur if the SWMP combined multiple truck loads of solid waste into a single transfer**  
4 **trailer and thereby reduce the number of trucks directly hauling solid waste to off-**  
5 **reservation landfills; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Nation successfully applied for and received \$291,933.52 (Resolution No. 04-286)**  
7 **from the U.S. Interagency Solid Waste Task Force, whose members are federal**  
8 **agencies including the Environmental Protection Agency, the Indian Health Service,**  
9 **and the Bureau of Indian Affairs, for purchasing solid waste and recycling transfer**  
10 **station equipment and construction services; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Management Program has expended \$192,304.02 to purchase and put**  
12 **in operation the transfer truck and trailer and has experienced operational savings;**  
13 **and**

14 **WHEREAS, there remains \$99,629.50 in the Nation's general fund to complete the project; and as**  
15 **stated in Resolution No. 04-286 "...designates this as a capital project and authorizes**  
16 **expenditure of funds until project is complete.";** and

17 **WHEREAS, the SWMP has been experiencing security breaches by illegal aliens, smugglers, cattle**  
18 **and horses and needs to make their yard more secure; and**

19 **WHEREAS, improved security fencing, automatic front gates, improved lighting, security**  
20 **cameras, loading dock expansion for two transfer trailers and other improvements**  
21 **will enable the SWMP to have a safer, more secure and efficient facility; and**

22 **WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee have**  
23 **reviewed this proposal and recommend approval by the Legislative Council.**

24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
25 **expenditure of \$99,629.50 as detailed in the attached budget to complete the solid**  
26 **waste transfer station and in addition continues to designate this as a capital project**  
27 **and authorizes expenditure of funds until the project is complete.**

28 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
29 **Nation Chairman and Vice-Chairman and any designated official are authorized to**  
30 **administer the Executive Branch FY-2011 Budget, provided however that any**
