

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Acceptance and Approval of the U. S Department of Justice Office of the Community Oriented Policing Service (COPS) Technology Program Grant in the amount of \$100,000.00)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 11-096**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department applied for and was awarded the U.S.**  
2 **Department of Justice (USDOJ), Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS)**  
3 **Technology Program Grant in the amount of \$100,000.00 for the enhancement of radio**  
4 **communication throughout the Tohono O'odham Nation to expand the radio coverage**  
5 **from about 65% to 92%; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the grant award period is from December 16, 2009 through December 15, 2012; and**

7 **WHEREAS, this grant does not allow for Indirect Cost; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the attached COPS Technology Program Grant has been prepared in the amount of**  
9 **\$100,000.00 for the approved budget category by the USDOJ COPS grant for equipment**  
10 **and has been reviewed by the budget office, Grants & Contracts, Executive, Domestic**  
11 **Affairs and Budget & Finance; and**

12 **WHEREAS, all recommend acceptance and approval of the grant and attached budget by the**  
13 **Legislative Council.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts and**  
15 **authorize the Tohono O'odham Nation's Chairman to accept the US Department of**  
16 **Justice COPS Technology Program Grant Award No. 2010CKWX0333 in the amount of**  
17 **\$100,000.00 on a reimbursement basis from the Tohono O'odham Nation General**  
18 **Fund.**

19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby approves and**  
20 **authorizes expenditures in accordance with the attached FY 2011 budget.**

21 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and authorizes**  
22 **the Tohono O'odham Police Department to expend funds from the COPS Technology**  
23 **Program Grant in accordance with the terms of the grant award period 12/16/2009 to**  
24 **12/15/2012 and further waives the indirect cost to administer the grant.**

25 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby authorizes the**  
26 **Chairman and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**  
27 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be**  
28 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**
