

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Tohono O'odham Nation, Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Community Health, FY 2011 Department of Justice, the Office of Violence Against Women (OVW) grant under the Grants to Indian Tribal Government Budget, incorporating carry-over savings, in the amount of \$139,237.73)

RESOLUTION NO. 11-102

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation through the Department of Health and Human Services,
2 Community Health Division received a grant to provide crisis intervention services to
3 victims of domestic violence from Department of Justice, Violence Against Women
4 Grant number 2007-TW-AX-0055; and

5 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation, Community Health division has received approval to
6 utilize the carry-over funds from the prior years, FY 09 and FY 10 from the grant to
7 continue to provide crisis intervention services to victims of domestic violence; and

8 WHEREAS, Department of Justice did issue a one-year no cost extension from August 31, 2010 to
9 August 31, 2011; and

10 WHEREAS, a budget in the amount of \$139,237.73 has been prepared using the combined carry-
11 over amounts of \$89,421.81 from FY 09 and \$49,815.92 from FY 10.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby:

- 13 1. Approves the carry-over budget in the amount of \$139,237.73.
- 14 2. Authorizes expenditures in accordance with the DOJ OVW fiscal year 2011 attached
15 budget, retroactive to August 31, 2010 and to expire August 31, 2011.

16 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the
17 Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as
18 attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be
19 submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

20 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 23RD Day
21 of MARCH, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,595.50 FOR; -0-
22 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article
23 VI, Section 1 (g) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
24 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
25 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
26 Stat. 984).
