

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Continuation award for the Family Violence Prevention and Services
Grant from the U.S. Department of Human Services Administration for Children
and Families FY2011)**

RESOLUTION NO. 11-103

1 **WHEREAS, prevention of injuries is priority for the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

2 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Violence Program within the Department of Health and Human Services**
3 **Community Health Division, and the Domestic Violence Coalition are working to raise**
4 **awareness of domestic violence and continue the development of services for**
5 **domestic violence victims and their families; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Health and Human Services received a**
7 **Family Violence Prevention and Services State Grant award in FY10 for a total of**
8 **\$137,717.00; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the grant has an expenditure period effective, 10/01/2009 and ending 09/30/2011; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Administration for Children and Families approved continued expenditures from**
11 **October 1, 2010, through September 30, 2011, of this grant in the amount of**
12 **\$137,717.00.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby:**

14 **1. Accepts and approves the grant award G-10PCAZFVPS DHHS/ACF Family Violence**
15 **Prevention and Services Budget effective 10/01/2009 and ending 09/30/2011 and**
16 **authorizes the expenditure of funds in the amount of \$137,717.00.**

17 **2. Approves the Family Violence Prevention and Services budget retroactive to**
18 **October 1, 2010 through September 30, 2011 in the amount of \$137,717.00,**
19 **attached hereto.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
21 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
22 **attached hereto, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level**
23 **shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
24 **Council.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 23RD Day**
26 **of MARCH, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,595.50 FOR; -0-**
27 **AGAINST; [01] NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
28 **Article VI, Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
29 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
30 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
31 **Stat. 984).**
