

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorization to carry forward \$42,207.17 from the FY 2010 ARRA - I.H.S. Budget
11-1124, extend the 11-1124 budget to June 30, 2011 and to transfer five existing
positions and staff members from 11-1124 Budget to 01-1097 effective April 1, 2011)**

RESOLUTION NO. 11-105

1 **WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Management Program's (SWMP) Dump Closure ARRA-I.H.S. 11-1124**
2 **Budget for FY 2011 in the amount of \$196,013.59 through March 31, 2011 was approved**
3 **with Resolution No. 10-372; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Grants and Contracts Office has calculated that an additional \$42,207.17 is**
5 **available as unobligated carry forward funds; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the SWMP requests an additional three months to June 30, 2011 which is the**
7 **completion date for the project as stated in I.H.S. Requisition No. 1230 to complete its**
8 **dump closure projects and to expend the additional operational funds; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the five staff positions have performed dump closure, solid waste and heavy**
10 **equipment services for the Tohono O'odham Nation since 2002; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the five staff positions in 11-1124 budget are slated for layoff on March 31, 2011; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the transfer of SWMP staff positions from 11-1124 to 01-1097 will enable the SWMP to**
13 **complete the dump closures and to continue to provide solid waste, emergency**
14 **response and heavy equipment services to the Tohono O'odham; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the SWMP has identified funds within their existing 01-1097 budget in the amount of**
16 **\$93,986.41 that will cover the personnel costs with fringe for 6 months; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the FY2011 SWMP/ARRA - I.H.S. Budget 11-1124 has been reviewed and approved by the**
18 **Legislative Natural Resources Committee and the Legislative Budget and Finance**
19 **Committee.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the**
21 **expenditure of carry forward funds in the amount of \$42,207.17, for the SWMP FY2011**
22 **ARRA - I.H.S. budget 11-1124, and that the budget be extended for an additional three**
23 **months to June 30, 2011 in accordance with the budget attached hereto.**

24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the transfer**
25 **of two Heavy Equipment Operator positions, one Equipment Operator/Driver II**
26 **position, and two Laborer positions and that the existing staff be transferred into**
27 **these positions in 01-1097 FY-2011 Budget.**

2 **Nation's Officials, to wit, the Chairman and Vice-Chairman and any designated official**
3 **are authorized to negotiate and execute the agreement, provided however, that any**
4 **amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the agreement shall be submitted**
5 **for further approval.**

6 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 23RD Day**
7 **of MARCH, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,160.70 FOR; 230.10**
8 **AGAINST; 204.70 [03] NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
9 **by Article VI, Section 1 (d)(2)(3) and (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted**
10 **by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
11 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
12 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
