

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approval of Higher Education Services Program FY 2011 Budget Amendment #1 - Account #10-1215)**

RESOLUTION NO. 11-129

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation through the Higher Education Services Program has been**  
2 **successfully providing counseling and financial assistance to eligible Tohono**  
3 **O'odham to attend Post Secondary Institutes; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Higher Education Services Program FY 2011 Base Budget is at \$692,975.00 plus**  
5 **Indirect Cost of \$9,831.05, a total of \$702,806.05, and the Grants and Contracts Office**  
6 **has received the Bureau of Indian Affairs FY 2010 Final Allocation, Modification #120**  
7 **in the amount of \$779,060.00, an increase of \$86,085.00; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Higher Education Services Program, through the Grants and Contract Office, has**  
9 **identified Carry-forward funds in the amount of \$442,774.21; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Higher Education Services Program FY 2011 Budget of \$692,975.00 will be**  
11 **increased \$528,859.21 plus the Indirect Cost of \$11,072.08 bringing the total budget to**  
12 **\$1,232,906.29; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the FY 2011 Higher Education Services Program Amendment #1 will increase line**  
14 **items 626 (Allowances and Stipends), 721 (Supplies-Other), 810 (Professional Services)**  
15 **and 812 (Public Relations); and**

16 **WHEREAS, the FY 2011 Higher Education Services Program Amendment #1 reflects an increase**  
17 **of the Indirect Cost of \$1,241.03, bringing the total budget to \$1,232,906.29.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
19 **Higher Education Services Program Budget Amendment #1 reflecting the FY 2011 Final**  
20 **Allocation of \$779,060.00 and FY 2010 Carry-Forward funds in the amount of**  
21 **\$442,774.21, and an increase Indirect Cost of \$1,241.03, bringing the total budget to**  
22 **\$1,232,906.29.**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Chairman or Vice-Chairman is hereby**  
24 **authorized to execute the budget provided that any amendment affecting the funding**  
25 **or funding levels of the budget shall be submitted for approval by the Tohono**  
26 **O'odham Legislative Council.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
28 **of APRIL, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,595.50 FOR; -0-**  
29 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article**  
30 **VI, Section 1 (d)(2)(3) & (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**  
31 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
32 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
33 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
