RESOLUTION NO. 11-135

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did convene on April 5, 2011 to address issues**  
2 **pertaining to the Nation; and**

3 **WHEREAS, on March 26, 2011, at a regularly scheduled meeting, the Gu Achi District Council did**  
4 **approve budget amendments for Sikol Himatk Community (Amendment #2,**  
5 **Resolution #0311-431), Ak Chin Community (Amendment #1, Resolution #0311-432)**  
6 **and Palo Verde Stand Community (Amendment #1, 0311-433) as attached hereto; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council's Budget and Finance Committee did review**  
8 **the communities' budget amendments submitted by the Gu Achi District and**  
9 **recommend for approval.**

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**  
11 **approve the Gu Achi District FY 2011 Budget Amendments for Sikol Himatk**  
12 **Community (Amendment #2), Ak Chin Community (Amendment #1) and Palo Verde**  
13 **Stand Community (Amendment #1) as attached hereto.**

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the amendments do not affect the overall portion of the Gaming**  
15 **Distribution of \$1,705,922.80 allocated to the Gu Achi District.**

16 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Gu Achi District Council has the authority to modify its Fiscal**  
17 **Year 2011 budget in accordance with protocols set forth by this Council. Any**  
18 **amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the Gu Achi District's Fiscal Year**  
19 **2011 budget shall be approved by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that this resolution will be executed in an expedient manner.**

21 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 05<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
22 **of APRIL, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,421.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
23 **-0- NOT VOTING; and 174.50[04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article**  
24 **VI, Section 1 (d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**  
25 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
26 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
27 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
