

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approval of the FY 2011 Budget Amendment No 2. for the Tohono O'odham Nation**  
**Police Department - Corrections Program Budget in the amount of \$1,901,727.17,**  
**Account No. 10-1093)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 11-169**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation contracts its own Law Enforcement, Ranger and**  
2 **Corrections Programs under the PL 93-638 BIA Master Contract; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department (TONPD) has been advised of carry**  
4 **over savings from Grants & Contracts, in the amount of \$1,309,508.17, and has also**  
5 **received Modification No. 149 in the amount of \$246,000.00 a onetime funding and**  
6 **Modification No. 138 in the amount of \$346,219.00 a onetime funding for a total of**  
7 **\$1,901,727.17; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the TONPD Corrections Program has amended its budget to include these amounts by**  
9 **adding new line items 720 Office Supplies, 723 Uniforms, 728 Ammunition, 754**  
10 **Firearms & Tasers, 774 Computer Maintenance, 812 Public Relations and 750 Major**  
11 **Capital; and**

12 **WHEREAS, line item 610.5 Other Compensation and 620 Fringe Benefits has been increased to**  
13 **cover any overage that may occur this fiscal year for salary cost; and**

14 **WHEREAS, existing line items within the budget have also been increased; and**

15 **WHEREAS, Modification No. 138 has been added to line item 810 Professional Services for contract**  
16 **beds; and**

17 **WHEREAS, with this increase has changed the budget amount from \$3,400,105.86 to \$5,432,750.44**  
18 **an increase of \$1,901,727.17 and indirect cost increase of \$130,917.41 for total increase**  
19 **of \$2,032,644.58.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**  
21 **approves and authorizes Budget Amendment No. 2 for the TONPD Corrections**  
22 **Program as follows:**

- 23 **1) Received carry over savings in the amount of \$1,309,508.17, Modification No. 149**  
24 **in the amount of \$246,000.00 and Modification No. 138 in the amount of**  
25 **\$346,219.00 both modifications are one time funding.**
- 26 **2) Create new line items 720 Office Supplies, 723 Uniforms, 728 Ammunition, 754**  
27 **Firearms & Tasers, 774 Computer Maintenance, 812 Public Relations and 750**  
28 **Major Capital.**
- 29 **3) Increase line items 610.5 Other Compensation and 620 Fringe Benefits to cover**  
30 **anticipated overage in the salary line item for fiscal year 2011.**

- 4) Increase existing line items and has added one time funding Modification No. 138 in the amount of \$346,219.00 to line item 810 Professional Services.
- 5) Total increase of \$1,901,727.17 with increase in the Indirect Cost of \$130,917.41 changing existing budget amount from \$2,032,644.58 to revised total amount of \$5,432,750.44.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby authorizes the Chairman and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09<sup>TH</sup> Day of MAY, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,595.50 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
