

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the Tohono O'odham Nation Vocational Rehabilitation Program FY 2010
Carryover Funds in the Amount of \$104,918.49 into Budget Modification/
Amendment 1 into FY 2011 Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 11-175

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has previously supported the Nation's**
2 **Education Department in submitting a grant proposal that established the Vocational**
3 **Rehabilitation Program under Resolution No. 03-149; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation was awarded a grant under the U.S. Department of**
5 **Education Office of Special Education Rehabilitative Services/Rehabilitation Services**
6 **Administration's Section 121 (Vocational Rehabilitation Services Projects for**
7 **American Indians with Disabilities) of the Rehabilitation Act and received grant**
8 **notification number H250D080009; and**

9 **WHEREAS, services will be provided to eligible enrolled Tohono O'odham members with**
10 **disabilities living on or near the Nation, and other federally recognized American**
11 **Indians with disabilities living on the Nation; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the services provided will be consistent with individual strengths, resources,**
13 **priorities, concerns, abilities, capabilities, and informed choice so that they may**
14 **prepare for, engage in, and maintain gainful employment; and**

15 **WHEREAS, a carryover amount has been identified from fiscal year 2010 in the amount of**
16 **\$104,918.49, and is added into the current program budget of \$433,277.00, which will**
17 **increase the total budget to \$538,195.49.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
19 **approves the Vocational Rehabilitation Program's FY 2011 Budget**
20 **Modification/Amendment 1 reflecting carryover funds in the amount of \$104,918.49,**
21 **which will be added to the current program base budget of \$433,277.00 for a grand**
22 **total of \$538,195.49; and increases the Indirect Cost from \$48,246.98 to \$50,929.83.**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
24 **Nation's Official, to wit: the Chairman is authorized to execute and expend the grant**
25 **award to September 30, 2011, and provide continued culturally appropriate**
26 **vocational rehabilitation services to its clients, provided however, that any**
27 **amendments affecting the funding level of this grant shall be submitted for further**
28 **approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

29 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH Day**
30 **of MAY, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,595.50 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
31 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI,**
32 **Section 1 (d)(2)&(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
33 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
34 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
35 **Stat. 984).**
