

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Setting May 26, 2011 Special Session to Address Nation's Proposed Water Code)**

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 11-183

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power "to establish rules and procedures to**
2 **regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing committees, boards**
3 **and special committees." (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI,**
4 **Section 1(a)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council vests the Council with**
6 **the authority to "by majority vote, call for a special session" (Legislative Rules of the**
7 **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, Article I, Section 1.D.1.); and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council Water Resources Committee has requested a special session**
9 **on May 26, 2011 to address the Nation's proposed Water Code.**

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council sets a special**
11 **session on May 26, 2011 to address the Nation's proposed Water Code.**

12 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH day of**
13 **MAY, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,595.50 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
14 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of**
15 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham**
16 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
17 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
