

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving Carry Forward Funds for the Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Behavioral Health, FY2011 Methamphetamine and Suicide Prevention Initiative (MSPI) Funding Award)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 11-185**

1 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Behavioral Health provides**  
2 **substance abuse, mental health, and prevention services; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation submitted an application to the U.S. Department of**  
4 **Health and Human Services for a Methamphetamine and Suicide Prevention Initiative**  
5 **(MSPI) award. The Nation was notified on June 24, 2009, the application was accepted**  
6 **for funding in the amount of \$300,000.00; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the approved funds aim to increase the suicide crisis response capacity of the Tohono**  
8 **O'odham Nation by training gatekeepers in Applied Suicide Intervention Skills**  
9 **Training (ASIST) and by enhancing the surveillance, reporting and response to the**  
10 **Tohono O'odham Nation members who are at risk for suicide; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Methamphetamine and Suicide Prevention Initiative award is a Congressional**  
12 **allocation and therefore the funding is not eligible for indirect costs as a condition of**  
13 **the award; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Methamphetamine and Suicide Prevention Initiative award for the initial**  
15 **\$300,000.00 was reviewed, approved and agreed to extend the utilization in the FY2010**  
16 **Methamphetamine and Suicide Prevention Initiative project year by Resolution 09-**  
17 **489 of the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the proposed carry forward of the**  
19 **identified savings in the amount of \$271,901.09 as presented in the attached Federal**  
20 **Financial Report; and authorizes the program to expend funds as budgeted in FY2011.**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:**

- 22 **1. Approves the FY2010 Methamphetamine and Suicide Prevention Initiative carry**  
23 **forward funds in the amount of \$271,901.09 be utilized in FY2011.**
- 24 **2. The Methamphetamine and Suicide Prevention Initiative award is a Congressional**  
25 **allocation and therefore is not eligible for indirect costs as a condition of the**  
26 **award.**

27 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**  
28 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**  
29 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be**  
30 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

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1 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12<sup>TH</sup> Day  
2 of MAY, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,595.50 FOR; -0- AGAINST;  
3 -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI,  
4 Section 1 (d)(2)(3) and (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
5 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
6 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
7 Stat. 984).
