

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Removing Names of Deceased from Reports Required by Legislative Order No. 03-370)**

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 11-190

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the authority to "establish
2 rules and procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council,
3 standing committees, boards, and special committees" (Constitution, Article VI,
4 Section 1(a)); and

5 WHEREAS, in 2003 the Legislative Council approved Legislative Order No. 03-370 directing the
6 Legislative Council officers to report "outstanding travel per diem" amounts to the full
7 Legislative Council on a quarterly basis (Legislative Order No. 03-370); and

8 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has acknowledged that during the time period when the
9 outstanding travel per diem reports were initially generated, the Legislative Council
10 administration did not keep accurate records of expenditures and expenditures that
11 were authorized were not adequately accounted for through proper documentation
12 (Legislative Order No. 03-372); and

13 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council understands the need out of respect to remove the names of
14 deceased former Legislative Council representatives from the quarterly reports
15 generated pursuant to Legislative Order No. 03-370.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that reports
17 generated pursuant to Legislative Order No. 03-370 shall not include information
18 concerning deceased Legislative Council representatives.

19 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH day of
20 MAY, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,457.0 FOR; 138.50 AGAINST;
21 -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of
22 Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham
23 Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
24 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
