

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving Realty Program's Request to Utilize FY2010 Carryover Savings for Program**  
**FY2011 BIA 638 Budget Amendment #1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 11-193

1 WHEREAS, the Realty Program is an office under the Planning and Economic Development  
2 Department and is partially funded by BIA 638 Master Contract; and

3 WHEREAS, the Realty Program has identified sufficient carryover savings available to utilize for  
4 the FY2011 budget; and

5 WHEREAS, the Realty Program has prepared a budget amendment to utilize carryover savings in  
6 the amount of \$19,410.00 for operational purposes which include new line items 622-  
7 Employee Security Clearance; 711-Communication Expense; 723-Uniforms and 855-  
8 Consumables; and increasing line items 630-Insurance; 650-Tuition and Registration;  
9 655-Lodging; 660-Travel Expense; 661-Mileage POV; 720-Supplies-Office; and

10 WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee have  
11 reviewed and recommended approval of the Realty Program FY 2011 BIA 638 Budget  
12 Amendment #1.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby accepts  
14 and approves the Realty Program FY 2011 BIA 638 Budget Amendment #1 with  
15 carryover savings in the amount of \$19,410.00 for operational purposes which include  
16 new line items 622-Employee Security Clearances; 711-Communication Expense; 723-  
17 Uniforms and 855-Consumables; and increases line items 630-Insurance; 650-Tuition  
18 and Registration; 655-Lodging; 660-Travel Expense; 661-Mileage POV and 720-  
19 Supplies-Office.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Realty Program FY2011 BIA 638 Budget Amendment #1  
21 increases the Direct Cost of the budget for \$26,493.84 to \$45,903.84 the Indirect Cost  
22 from \$4,583.43 to \$7,653.75 for a total budget increase from \$31,077.27 to \$53,577.59.

23 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the  
24 Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as  
25 attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds of funding level shall be  
26 submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

27 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13<sup>TH</sup> Day  
28 of MAY, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,390.80 FOR; -0- AGAINST;  
29 -0- NOT VOTING; and 204.70 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article  
30 VI, Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
31 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
32 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
33 Stat. 984).
