(Approving the Budget Amendment #1 of Account 11-1096 for the US Department of
Homeland Security, FEMA, 2008 Homeland Security Grant Program
#2008-GE-T8-0063)

RESOLUTION NO. 11-207

1 **WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management**
2 **Agency (FEMA) has distributed grants states to fund for purchases that provide public**
3 **safety services within their respective jurisdictions; and**

4 **WHEREAS, eligible Indian tribes have been designated to receive direct funding from the**
5 **Department of Homeland Security - FEMA established from the 9-11**
6 **Recommendations Act; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation was awarded a grant from the Department of Homeland**
8 **Security, FEMA in the amount of \$175,500.00 as part of the 2008 Homeland Security**
9 **Grant Program which was accepted by Resolution #09-392; and**

10 **WHEREAS, an Amendment of the grant (Account 11-1096) is required to include Other**
11 **Compensation to allow for overtime and backfill of personnel during approved**
12 **training; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Budget Amendment #1 of Account 11-1096 has been reviewed by the Budget Office,**
14 **Grants & Contracts Department, Executive Office, Domestic Affairs Committee and**
15 **Budget & Finance Committee, of which all recommend approval of the Amendment by**
16 **the Legislative Council.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
18 **Budget Amendment #1 to Account 11-1096 for the 2008 Homeland Security Grant**
19 **Program grant #2008-GE-T8-0063.**

20 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the line number 610.5 Other Compensation will be added to the**
21 **Budget Amendment to allow for overtime and backfill of personnel during approved**
22 **training.**

23 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tohono O'odham Legislative council authorizes the Office of**
24 **Emergency Management to expend funds from the FEMA 2008 Homeland Security**
25 **Grant Program in accordance with the terms of the grant award period of 09/01/08 to**
26 **08/31/2011.**

27 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
28 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the Budget as**
29 **attached, provided that any Amendments affecting the funds or funding levels is**
30 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**
