RESOLUTION NO. 11-208

1 WHEREAS, the One Stop Division Bureau of Indian Affairs - 477 Budget FY 2010 budget  
2 administers (WIA) P.L. 102-477 programs under the Education Department One Stop  
3 Division from February 1, 2009 to September 30, 2011 in the combined amount of  
4 \$288,020.00; and

5 WHEREAS, the One Stop Division Bureau of Indian Affairs - 477 Budget FY 2011 budget has been  
6 developed as part of the DOL Supplemental Youth Services for Native Americans 2009  
7 Recovery Act approved under Resolution No. 09-427; and

8 WHEREAS, the Education Department - One Stop Division and the Grants & Contracts office has  
9 identified a remaining balance in the amount of \$43,425.45 per Financial Status  
10 Report and requests to create a new budget to expend the funds; and


11 WHEREAS, the DOL Supplemental Youth Services budget was reviewed by the Human Resources  
12 Development Committee and the Budget & Finance Committee.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby  
14 accept, approve, and authorize the expenditure of the DOL Supplemental Youth  
15 Services Budget Contract No. GTK00T142AR, Education Department-One Stop Division  
16 Bureau of Indian Affairs - 477 ARRA Budget FY 2011 of \$43,425.45.

17 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham  
18 Nation's Officials, to wit; the Chairperson and any official appointed designee is hereby  
19 authorized to expend the budget provided however, that any amendment affecting the  
20 funding or funding levels of this budget shall be submitted for further prior approval  
21 by this Council.

22 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 27<sup>th</sup> Day  
23 of MAY, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,595.50 FOR; -0- AGAINST;  
24 -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI,  
25 Section 1 (d)(2)(3) & (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
26 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
27 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
28 Stat. 984).
