

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Suspending Tohono O'odham Ki:Ki Association Board of Directors)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 11-211**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the authority to enact**  
2 **ordinances "to promote, protect and provide for public health, peace, morals,**  
3 **education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members"**  
4 **(Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council established the Tohono O'odham Ki:Ki Association ("TOKA") as**  
6 **a separate tribal entity in accordance with Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono**  
7 **O'odham Nation and pursuant to Legislative Council Ordinance No. 98-03, as amended**  
8 **("TOKA Ordinance"), 18 T.O.C. Ch. 1 ([www.tolc-nsn.org/docs/Title18Ch1.pdf](http://www.tolc-nsn.org/docs/Title18Ch1.pdf)); and**

9 **WHEREAS, the TOKA Ordinance authorizes the Legislative Council to appoint five members to the**  
10 **TOKA's Board of Directors and vests the Council with the authority to "by resolution,**  
11 **suspend some or all of the duties and responsibilities of a Director of the Board for a**  
12 **period not to exceed six months." (TOKA Ordinance, Article V, Section 3); and**

13 **WHEREAS, it is in the Nation's best interest to suspend the current TOKA Directors pending**  
14 **further action by the Legislative Council, provided that the suspension shall not**  
15 **exceed six months.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**  
17 **suspends TOKA Directors Gloria Pancho, Gloria Bracamonte, and Noreen Ignacio-**  
18 **Pablo from the TOKA Board of Directors pending further action by the Legislative**  
19 **Council.**

20 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Directors suspended by this resolution shall not participate**  
21 **in the affairs of the TOKA or its Board, have access to TOKA records or property, or**  
22 **otherwise exercise any authority as a TOKA Director.**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Directors' suspensions shall end six months from the effective**  
24 **date of this resolution except as otherwise provided by subsequent action of the**  
25 **Legislative Council.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 27<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
27 **of MAY, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,995.0 FOR; 600.50**  
28 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article**  
29 **VI, Section 1 (b) and 1 (c)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**  
30 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
31 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
32 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
