

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the FY 2011 budget amendment No. 3 for the 638 Corrections Program
changing budget from \$5,432,750.44 to \$5,486,140.86)

RESOLUTION NO. 11-247

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation contracts its own Law Enforcement, Ranger and**
2 **Corrections Programs under the 638 BIA Master Contract; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department (TONPD) Corrections Program has**
4 **received additional funding from the Bureau of Indian Affairs through modifications**
5 **No. 159 for \$10,224.00, modification no. 160 for \$19,928.00, modification No. 161 for**
6 **\$15,551.00 for a total of \$45,703.00; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the TONPD Corrections Program has amended the FY 2011 budget to include these**
8 **modification in operational cost; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the line items that were increase were line item 710 Utilities, 721 Supplies Other, 722**
10 **Program Supplies and 770 Repair & Maintenance Equipment; and**

11 **WHEREAS, this increase has changed the budget from \$5,432,750.44 to \$5,486,140.86 a difference**
12 **of \$53,390.24; and**

13 **WHEREAS, this has also changed the indirect cost from \$581,835.25 to \$589,522.67 a difference of**
14 **\$7,687.42.**

15 **WHEREAS, the FY 2011 Corrections Budget Amendment No. 3 has been reviewed by the Budget**
16 **Office, the Grants & Contracts Office, the Executive Office, and the Legislative Domestic**
17 **Affairs and Budget & Finance Committees, all of which recommend approval by the**
18 **Legislative Council.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
20 **approves and authorizes Budget Amendment No. 3 as follows:**

21 **1) Received additional funding from the Bureau of Indian Affairs under**
22 **modifications No. 159 for \$10,224.00, modification no. 160 for \$19,928.00,**
23 **modification No. 161 for \$15,551.00 for a total of \$45,703.00.**

24 **2) Line items were increase under the 638 Corrections budget as follows, 710 Utilities,**
25 **721 Supplies Other, 722 Program Supplies and 770 Repair & Maintenance**
26 **Equipment.**

27 **3) Changing total budget from \$5,432,750.44 to \$5,486,140.86 a difference of**
28 **\$53,390.24.**

6 submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council


7 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 22ND Day**




