

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Adult Protective Services 2011 Budget Amendment #1 Account: 01-1303)**

RESOLUTION NO. 11-254

1 **WHEREAS, the Division of Adult Protective Services FY 2011 budget was prepared and approved**
2 **by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council to provide services to abused and**
3 **vulnerable adults; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the original 2011 budget did not include line items for program activities necessary**
5 **to provide quality services to clients; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the 2011 Adult Protective Services (APS) budget also did not include adequate funding**
7 **to purchase additional supplies and equipment needed to provide program services;**
8 **and**

9 **WHEREAS, the attached budget amendment was prepared to decrease some line items in order**
10 **to increase the funds in other line items that includes: 712- Gas, Oil and Coolants; 721-**
11 **Supplies Other; 751 – Lease and Rentals; 771 – Vehicle Repair & Maintenance and the**
12 **two created line items; 810 – Professional Services and 812 Public Relations; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee**
14 **of the Legislative Council have reviewed this Budget amendment and recommend its**
15 **approval and adoption.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
17 **approves the Adult Protective Services 2011 Budget Amendment #1 decreasing some**
18 **of the line items and increasing the funds in other line items that includes: 712-Gas,**
19 **Oil and Coolant; 721-Supplies Other; 751-Lease/Rentals; 771 – Vehicle Repair &**
20 **Maintenance and the two created line items; 810-Professional Services and 812 Public**
21 **Relations.**

22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation officials to wit, the Chairperson and**
23 **any designated official is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant,**
24 **provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of this**
25 **budget shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 22ND Day**
27 **of JUNE, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
28 **-0- NOT VOTING; and -0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI,**
29 **Section 1 (d)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham**
30 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
31 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


