

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving the FY 2011 Department of Health & Human Services Title IVB  
Subpart 2 budget 11-1345 Amendment #1 for Division of Child Welfare)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 11-260**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has historically contracted certain functions from the**  
2 **Department of Health & Human Services; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated and wishes to continue operating a Division**  
4 **of Child Welfare Services to intervene against child abuse and neglect and to promote**  
5 **safe and stable families; and**

6 **WHEREAS, Title IV B, Subpart 2 grants require a 25% match, which the Nation matches through**  
7 **the P.L. 93-638 master contract, specifically the BIA Social Services budget for child**  
8 **welfare services and the BIA ICWA budget for Family Preservation Program, as**  
9 **authorized by both P.L. 93-638 and the Department of Health & Human Services; and**

10 **WHEREAS, these Title IV B budgets are authorized for only a two year expenditure period,**  
11 **beginning October 1, 2010 and ending September 30, 2012, funding only the two fiscal**  
12 **years of FY 2011 and FY 2012; and**

13 **WHEREAS, Title IV B, Subpart 2 Budget 11-1345 was estimated at \$248,532.00 and was awarded**  
14 **\$236,404.00 decreasing the budget by \$12,128 in the line items 660 Travel Expense, 721**  
15 **Other Supplies and 810 Professional Services; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health & Human Services is in receipt of the Notice of Award as Title**  
17 **IV-B, Subpart 2 Budget 11-1345 with 10% IDC @ \$19,446.71 for a total of \$236,404.00;**  
18 **and**

19 **WHEREAS, the Executive Office, the Health and Human Service Oversight Committee and the**  
20 **Budget & Finance Committee has reviewed and approved this budget.**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**  
22 **approves the Title IV-B, Subpart 2 Budget 11-1345 with an IDC @ 10%, increasing the**  
23 **IDC from \$19,231.07 to \$19,446.71 and decreasing the budget from \$248,532.00 for a**  
24 **new total of \$236,404.00.**

25 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**  
26 **Chairman and any designated official to expend and administer the budget, as**  
27 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be**  
28 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**
