

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY-2011 Budget Amendment/Modification #1 for Real Property Management)**

RESOLUTION NO. 11-297

1 **WHEREAS, the Planning and Economic Development Department's Real Property Management**
2 **Program provides, for the Da Vita Dialysis and San Simon Housing Units; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Real Property Management Program has reviewed its FY 2011 Budget, and needs**
4 **to amend the budget to increase line items dollar amounts and cover over budgeted**
5 **line items; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the budget amendment decrease line item 650 Tuition and Registration by (\$2,098.14);**
7 **and decreases line item 810 Professional Services by (\$6,698.21); zeros out line item**
8 **655 Lodging (\$9,967.79); for a total decrease of (\$18,764.14) that will be disturbed to**
9 **other line items; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the budget amendment increases 612 Occasional Appointment by \$2,113.83 to cover**
11 **the negative balance; 620 Fringe Benefits by \$232.52; 712 Gas Oil and Coolants by**
12 **\$5,448.45; 720 Supplies Office by \$4,000; 721 Supplies Other by \$3,969.34; 723 Uniforms**
13 **by \$3,000; for a total increase of \$18,764.14; and**


14 **WHEREAS, the Commerce and Budget & Finance Committees, have reviewed and approved the**
15 **Real Property Management FY-2011 Budget Amendment #1.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council hereby**
17 **approves the Real Property Management FY-2011 Budget Amendment/Modification**
18 **#1 in accordance with the budget attached.**

19 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council hereby authorizes**
20 **the Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget, as**
21 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the**
22 **budget shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Nation**
23 **Legislative Council.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13th Day**
25 **of JULY, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
26 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2)**
27 **and (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
28 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
29 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
30 **Stat. 984).**
