

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Supporting the Nomination of Joseph T. Joaquin for a 2011 Arizona Indian  
Living Treasure Award)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 11-304**

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with the**  
2 **authority to "preserve and cultivate native arts, crafts and traditions" (Constitution,**  
3 **Article VI, Section 1(c)(8)); and**

4 **WHEREAS, since 1988, the Arizona Indian Living Treasures Awards, Inc. ("AILTA"), a non-profit**  
5 **organization, has recognized and honored lifetime achievements of Arizona Native**  
6 **American artists or educators 60 years of age or older; and**

7 **WHEREAS, Joseph T. Joaquin has been nominated for a 2011 Living Treasure Award for his**  
8 **longtime efforts and contributions in promoting and preserving the Tohono O'odham**  
9 **language, culture, and traditions through education both on and off the reservation;**  
10 **and**

11 **WHEREAS, Joseph T. Joaquin serves the Nation in his current capacity as Cultural Resources**  
12 **Specialist within the Nation's Cultural Affairs Office and was influential in the**  
13 **establishment of the Cultural Affairs Office which has enabled the Nation to be**  
14 **proactive in the preservation and nurturing of its cultural identity; and**

15 **WHEREAS, Joseph T. Joaquin represents the Nation on various national boards and committees,**  
16 **including membership on the National Congress of American Indians Native American**  
17 **Graves Protection and Repatriation Act ("NAGPRA") Elderly Advisory Committee since**  
18 **1998 (Resolution No. 98-481), and has also served as a former Legislative Council**  
19 **representative from 1989 to 1997; and**

20 **WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation Committee and the Office of the Chairman and Vice**  
21 **Chairwoman recommend the nomination of Joseph T. Joaquin for the 2011 Arizona**  
22 **Indian Living Treasure Award.**

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**  
24 **and supports the nomination of Joseph T. Joaquin for a 2011 Arizona Indian Living**  
25 **Treasure Award.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13<sup>th</sup> Day**  
27 **of JULY, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
28 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (c)(8)**  
29 **of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham**  
30 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**  
31 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
