

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Appropriating Desert Diamond Savings to Supplement the FY 2012 Projected
Revenues to the Nation and the Actual Gaming Distribution Revenues to
the Districts in the amount of \$13,484,531.60)**

RESOLUTION NO. 11-308

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council (the "Legislative Council") is vested with the**
2 **power "to manage any funds within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham**
3 **Nation" (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee and the Executive Office established the FY 2012**
5 **preliminary tribal operating budget for the Tohono O'odham Nation (the "Nation") at**
6 **\$72,987,256.74; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Nation was appropriated funding from Desert Diamond Savings in FY 2010 in the**
8 **amount of \$10,680,518.00 (Legislative Council resolution No. 09-265) and General Fund**
9 **Surplus Reserve in FY 2011 in the amount of \$9,890,616.75 (Legislative Council**
10 **resolution No. 10-291) to address the expected shortfalls in FY 2010 and in FY 2011,**
11 **respectively; and**

12 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Tohono O'odham Legislative Council resolution No. 09-265 and No. 10-289,**
13 **the Nation funded the shortfall for the Districts in FY 2010 and FY 2011 in the amount**
14 **of \$5,500,896.00 in each fiscal year from Desert Diamond Savings; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Nation's Treasurer has determined that the Nation and the Districts continue to**
16 **face economic recovery for FY 2012 and recommends the use of Desert Diamond**
17 **Savings of \$13,484,531.60 (\$7,983,635.60 for the Nation and \$5,500,896.00 for the**
18 **Districts) as an economic recovery plan for the Nation and its Districts during this time**
19 **of negative economic condition; and**

20 **WHEREAS, on April 19, 2011, the Executive Office provided a financial update to a majority of the**
21 **District Chairs, specifically from Chukut Kuk, Baboquivari, Sells, Schuk Toak,**
22 **Pisinemo, Gu Achi, and Hickiwan Districts.**

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
24 **appropriates \$13,484,531.60 (\$7,983,635.60 for the Nation and \$5,500,896.00 for the**
25 **Districts) to supplement the FY 2012 projected revenues to the Nation and the Actual**
26 **Gaming Distribution Revenues to the Districts for the purpose of funding the FY 2012**
27 **tribal budgets of the Tohono O'odham Nation and FY 2012 District budgets.**

28 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the FY 2012**
29 **Supplemental District Allocation shall be \$500,081.45 to each of the eleven districts.**



1 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that FY 2012 District
2 **Supplemental funds shall be made available for expenditure subject to budgets**
3 **approved in accordance with Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and Article IX, Section 7 of the**
4 **Nation's Constitution.**

5 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 19th Day**
6 **of JULY, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,162.85 FOR; 617.75**
7 **AGAINST; [02] NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
8 **Section 1 (d) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
9 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
10 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
11 **Stat. 984).**
