

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Child Welfare,
FY 2011 BIA ICWA Family Preservation 10-1312 Amendment #1)

RESOLUTION NO. 11-310

1 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 10-296, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the**
2 **Department of Health and Human Services FY 2011 BIA ICWA Family Preservation**
3 **budget in the amount of \$200,041.07; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Nation has identified prior years savings associated with the BIA ICWA Family**
5 **Preservation budget in the amount of \$53,388.25; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human services has prepared the attached FY 2011 BIA**
7 **ICWA Family Preservation budget amendment #1, which incorporates amounts in new**
8 **line items; 720 Supplies Office, 722 Program Supplies, 770 Repair & Maintenance**
9 **Equipment, 771 Repair & Maintenance Vehicle, 810 Professional Services, 812 Public**
10 **Relations, 850 Food, 856 Client Support and 750 Major Capital; with an increase to the**
11 **existing supplies other line item and decreasing the indirect cost rate from 17.3% to**
12 **16.82%; for a revised budget total in the following amount of \$255,955.95 which**
13 **includes \$32,029.70 for indirect cost; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Health & Human Services Committee and the Budget and Finance committee of**
15 **the Legislative Council have reviewed this budget and recommend its approval and**
16 **adoption.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
18 **the budget amendment #1, and authorizes the Executive Branch to expend the funds**
19 **in the total amount of \$255,955.95 effective October 1, 2010 through September 30,**
20 **2011, which amends the budget to incorporate new line items and decrease indirect**
21 **cost rate from 17.3% to 16.82% attached hereto.**

22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Child Welfare Division is hereby submitting budget**
23 **amendment #1, which incorporates amounts in new line items; 720 Supplies Office,**
24 **722 Program Supplies, 770 Repair & Maintenance Equipment, 771 Repair &**
25 **Maintenance Vehicle, 810 Professional Services, 812 Public Relations, 850 Food, 856**
26 **Client Support and 750 Major Capital; with an increase to the existing supplies other**
27 **line item.**

28 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
29 **Chairman and any designated official to expend and administer the budget, as**
30 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be**
31 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 19th Day of JULY, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(3)&(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
