

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approval of the Office on Violence Against Women (OVW) grant under the Grant  
to Indian Tribal Governments Program for \$900,000.00 for three years FY2012)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 11-332**

1 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, Management of Health Division**  
2 **coordinates services provision for its ten divisions; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation submitted an application to the Office on Violence**  
4 **Against Women (OVW) for funding under the Grants to Indian Tribal Governments**  
5 **Program in the amount of \$900,000.00 for the next 36 months, for the Tohono O'odham**  
6 **Nation; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Notice of award was received on September 28, 2009 for a three year grant project**  
8 **period 10/01/09-09/30/12 to implement the program, for sexual assault intervention,**  
9 **support services and advocacy to victims of sexual assault; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Violence Against Women funding of \$900,000.00 will be divided equally over the**  
11 **next three years; and**

12 **WHEREAS, a budget of \$300,000.00 has been prepared for Fiscal Year 2012; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee**  
14 **of the Legislative Council have reviewed this Budget and recommend its approval and**  
15 **adoption.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**  
17 **the FY 2012 Budget in the amount of \$300,000.00 and to utilize the Nations Resources**  
18 **pending reimbursement from the Grantor for the continuation of the Grant.**

19 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**  
20 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the Budget as**  
21 **attached, provided that any Amendments affecting the funds or funding level is**  
22 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 21<sup>st</sup> Day**  
24 **of JULY, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
25 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2)**  
26 **of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham**  
27 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**  
28 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


