RESOLUTION NO. 11-334

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has successfully operated the Tohono O'odham**
2 **Department of Health and Human Services-Division of Community Health-Women**
3 **Infants and Children (WIC) Program which provides preventive health care; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona through an Intergovernmental Agreement receives**
5 **funds from the United States Department of Agriculture for programs designed to**
6 **benefit women, infants and children; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has entered into a Memorandum of Agreement with the**
8 **Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona to fund and operate the Women Infants and Children**
9 **(WIC) Program which commenced on October 01, 2009 through September 30, 2012,**
10 **which was approved through Resolution Number 10-014; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the services provided to eligible clients have been beneficial and services continue to**
12 **be necessary to help alleviate nutritional health risks and improve the health of**
13 **individuals at risk; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Inter Tribal Council of Arizona assigned caseload is 1050 and grant level is**
15 **\$199,164.00 for the Women, Infant and Children (WIC) program effective October 1,**
16 **2011; and**

17 **WHEREAS, WIC has submitted the FY 2012 WIC Budget and proposal in the amount of \$199,164.00;**
18 **and**

19 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee**
20 **of the Legislative Council have reviewed this Budget and recommend its approval and**
21 **adoption.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
23 **the FY 2012 Budget in the amount of \$199,164.00 and to utilize the Nations Resources**
24 **pending reimbursement from the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona for the continuation**
25 **of the Agreement.**

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
27 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
28 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level is**
29 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**






