

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving Continuation award for the Family Violence Prevention and Services**  
**Grant from the U.S. Department of Human Services Administration for Children**  
**and Families FY2012)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 11-335**

1 **WHEREAS, prevention of injuries is priority for the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

2 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Violence Program within the Department of Health and Human Services**  
3 **Community Health Division, and the Domestic Violence Coalition are working to raise**  
4 **awareness of family violence and continue the development of services for domestic**  
5 **violence victims and their families; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Health and Human Services has**  
7 **continually received a Family Violence Prevention and Services State Grant award**  
8 **averaging a total of \$136,560.00; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Administration for Children and Families approves continued expenditures in two**  
10 **year increments, therefore the period would be from October 1, 2010, through**  
11 **September 30, 2012, of this grant in the estimated amount of \$136.560.00; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee**  
13 **of the Legislative Council have reviewed this Budget and recommend its approval and**  
14 **adoption.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby:**

- 16 **1. Accepts and approves the grant award from U.S.Department of Health & Human**  
17 **Services, Administration for Children and Families, Family Violence Prevention**  
18 **and Services budget effective 10/01/2010 and ending 09/30/2012 and authorizes the**  
19 **expenditure of funds in the amount of \$136,560.00.**
- 20 **2. Approves the Family Violence Prevention and Services budget.**
- 21 **3. To utilize the Nations Resources pending reimbursement from the Grantor for the**  
22 **continuation of the Grant.**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**  
24 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**  
25 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level is**  
26 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 21<sup>st</sup> Day**  
28 **of JULY, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
29 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of**  
30 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham**  
31 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**  
32 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**

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
